Clinton Shiells, a national of the United States, was appointed Deputy Director of the JVI in 2005. He has been an IMF staff member since 1993. Mr. Shiells worked in the IMF's Policy Development and Review and European II Departments for five years each and then in the IMF Institute for nearly two years. His country assignments include Armenia, Ethiopia, Indonesia, Lithuania, and Ukraine. Mr. Shiells studied economics and philosophy at the University of California at Berkeley, and received a Ph.D. in economics at the University of Michigan.
