



Max Watson

Max Watson is Economic Adviser to the Director-General of Economic and Financial Affairs of the European Commission. He is a senior member of St Antony's College, Oxford, and a visiting fellow in Euro-Asian studies at the University of Reading. He was formerly a Deputy Director at the IMF, where he had worked as mission chief for a number of East and West European economies in the 1990s; as head of the International Capital Markets Division and Debt Issues Unit in the 1980s; and earlier as Personal Assistant to Managing Director de Larosiere. He began his career in the International Department of the Bank of England, where he was later a manager in the Banking Supervision Division; Secretary of the International Conference of Bank Supervisors, and Secretary of the EU Groupe de Contact of Bank Supervisors. He also spent some time as a manager of eurobond issues at S.G. Warburg & Co. He was educated at Cambridge and INSEAD, and is a Fellow of the UK Institute of Financial Services.
