

Michael Deppler assumed office as Director of the European Department of the International Monetary Fund on February 6, 1997. He joined the Fund as an economist in 1971. He worked on the World Economic Outlook in the Research Department for the first half of his career, joining the European Department in 1987. Prior to joining the IMF, Mr. Deppler worked at the Federal Reserve Board and Council of Economic Advisors in Washington DC.

Mr. Deppler earned his Bachelor's degree from Brown University in 1964, and a Master's degree in International Relations and a Ph.D. in Economics from Georgetown University in 1968 and 1976, respectively.

Mr. Deppler, a U.S. national, was born in Brazil, on April 8, 1943.
