

Michael A. Landesmann is Scientific Director of the Vienna Institute for International Economic Studies (wiiw) and Professor of economics at the Johannes Kepler University Linz, Austria where he is also department head of economic theory and quantitative economics. His research focuses on international economics, economic growth and structural change. Apart from his participation in and co-ordination of a large number of international research projects (European Commission, ILO, UNCTAD, World Bank, etc.), Michael Landesmann is member of the Coordinating Committee of the European Trade Study Group (ETSG), a main European academic forum on international economics. In addition, he was member of the Group 'Economic Analysis', a Group of Economic Policy Advisors under the chairmanship of former EU Commission President Romano Prodi. In the past, Michael Landesmann was Fellow and Lecturer in Economics, Jesus College, Cambridge and Senior Research Officer at the Department of Applied Economics, University of Cambridge. He is Managing Editor: Structural Change and Economic Dynamics, North Holland. He was Schumpeter Research Professor at Harvard Univ. (USA) and held Visiting Professorships at the Graduate School of International Economics and Finance, Brandeis Univ. (USA), Bombay Univ. (India), Universities of Bologna, Modena and Padova (Italy), Central European University and CERGE-EI (Prague), Osaka City Univ. (Japan).
