

André Sapir is Professor of Economics at the European Centre for Advanced Research in Economics and Statistics (ECARES), Université Libre de Bruxelles (ULB), and Senior Fellow of the Brussels European and Global Economic Laboratory (BRUEGEL). He is also a Research Fellow of the Centre for Economic Policy Research (CEPR) and a member of European Commission President Jose Manuel Barroso's Economic Policy Analysis Group. He was an Economic Adviser to European Commission President Romano Prodi (2001-2004) and the Chairman of the High-Level Study Group appointed by him that produced the 2003 report "An Agenda for a Growing Europe", widely known as the "Sapir Report". His research focuses on two areas: economic integration and international trade.
