Susan Schadler joined the IMF in 1975 and held positions in the Research Department, Asian Department, and Policy Development and Review Department, before joining the European Department in 1999. She has headed IMF surveillance teams in industrial and transition countries, worked on a wide range of countries using Fund resources, and been involved with policy issues related to the use of Fund resources. During a sabbatical in 1998-99, she was adjunct professor at Georgetown University and a Senior Research Fellow at the International for Food Policy Research Institute.

Ms. Schadler has published extensively on macroeconomic issues. Most recently, she has co-authored several publications on euro adoption in the new member states and on the determinants of growth in these countries. She has also published several volumes analyzing IMF's lending arrangements to both middle income and low-income countries. Other published work focuses on exchange rate policies and macroeconomic issues in Asia.

She received a BA from Mount Holyoke College and an MSc in Economics from the London School of Economics.
