Prof. Axel Börsch-Supan is Director of the Munich Research Institute for the Economics of Aging and SHARE Analyses (MEA) in Munich, Germany, Research Associate at the National Bureau of Economic Research (NBER) in Cambridge, Mass., USA, and Principal Investigator and Managing Director of the Survey of Health, Ageing and Retirement in Europe (SHARE). Börsch-Supan holds a Ph.D. in economics from MIT, was Assistant Professor of Public Policy at Harvard, Professor for Macroeconomics and Public Policy at Mannheim University, and finally Director at the Max Planck Institute for Social Law and Social Policy and Professor at the Technical University of Munich.

Börsch-Supan is member of the German and Austrian Academies of Sciences. His policy consulting includes German Federal Presidents, the German Economics Ministry, German Pension Reform Commissions, French President Emanuel Macron, Senate of the United States of America, EU Commission, OECD, WHO, WEF and World Bank.
