He has published extensively in international macroeconomics, international finance, and monetary economics, and is the author of the books *The Economics of Central Banking*, published by Routledge, and *Redefining the Monetary Standard in the Digital Age*, published by Palgrave Macmillan.

In the area of climate and sustainability, he is the Chair of the Climate Scenarios Workstream in the Network for Greening the Financial System (NGFS) and is responsible in the ECB for all issues at the intersection of climate and finance, including climate stress tests and sustainable finance.
